### II. NARRATIVE REPORT/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

To ensure the safety of the students and faculty and to install in them the sense of preparedness in case of an unexpected earthquake, Yubo Extension High School together with Yubo Elementary School conducted the Quarter IV Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) 2018 at 2:00 P.M., November 7, 2018.

The students and faculty members were not informed except the school heads and the school DRRM Coordinators of the planned activity to assess the teachers' and students' efficiency to conduct and behave themselves in accordance to the **DO'S** and **DON'TS** during an earthquake as briefed in a series of earthquake drills previously conducted.


First, the bell was rung to signal students to do the "DUCK, COVER AND HOLD." The bell was shut down and 3 whistle signals were heard signaling the students and school personnel to go out from their respective rooms/offices while covering their heads and proceed safely to an open field/evacuation area free from falling debris and distant from large buildings or structures that may collapse any time due to an earthquake. Prior to these 2018 Q4 NSED, an earthquake drill was conducted during the Q2 Honors Day and General PTA Assembly last November 6, 2018 which were participated by the parents and other stakeholders.

Concluding the said activity was a reorientation on the things to be duly observed during an actual earthquake by the school head and the school DRRM Coordinator. Internal stakeholders were once more reminded to take it seriously and never to take it for granted considering that the calamity spells a life and death situation. Then pupils/students reiterated that they would not be sent home if they were not fetched by their respective parents/guardians.



Participants proceeding to the evacuation after securing it is safe to do so


